Know before you go (KBYG): We hosted a 2½ hour online "know before you go" webinar for all delegates, led by our Lead Coach who provided an orientation to the resources and journey ahead. This was scheduled T-1

Highlights

- week from the Hack the Cert start date. **Recommended self-paced study:** We recommended 8-hours of self-paced study as a pre-requisite to the Hack event.
- **Attendance** 6 participants joined on days 1 and 6 for the remainder of the event, with zero drop-offs. Team Numbers: The Hackathon is designed for an optimum team size of 6 participants. We had 1 dedicated
- team made up of 6 delegates.
- **Collaboration:** Delegate's level of knowledge was good and the high levels of collaboration amongst the teams worked really well.
- Knowledge sharing and connecting teams. To stimulate knowledge sharing and cross-team collaboration, we had a different representative from within the team to lead in each of the challenges. Hackathon Quiz. We ran quizzes after lunch every day which was a re-cap on some of the topics covered
- in the morning and the previous day. It was very well received and highlighted as one of the most enjoyable parts of the Hack.
- **Positive Feedback.** Comments from the learners were amazing. The work they were doing in the Hack was exactly what they were looking for. Other comments included good format, the atmosphere was friendly and relaxed, challenge format, quizzes, total immersion. They were very surprised at how much they have learned.
- Ratio of Virtual Coaches. We had a dedicated Coach for the team (1:6 Learners). **Remote Participation.** All learners were remote and using MS Teams.
